

# TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA

## JANUARY 24, 2007

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. All members were present. The meeting was call to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Joe Romine. There was a motion by Martz seconded by Jagers to approve the minutes from the January 10, 2007 meeting. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper, and Martz. Nays: No one.

**BIDS FOR TRASH REMOVAL:** There being three (3) sealed bids turned in by Waste Management, Wabash Valley, and Marion Services. Waste Management was \$10.45 a month for trash, and \$5.20 for recycling for one (1) year. Wabash Valley bid was \$8.50 for trash and \$2.50 for recycle for one (1) year. Marion Services bid was \$8.75 for both trash and recycle for three (3) years. Town's attorney reviewed all contracts and approved Marion Services to be lowest bidder. A motion by Bonham seconded by Cooper to accept bid form Marion Services. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper and Martz. Nays: No one.

**POLICE CAR BIDS:** There being five (5) bids turned in for replacement of 1999 Ford Explorer. 2007 Grand Cherokee at \$24,895.00, 2007 Ford Explorer at \$25,337.15, 2007 Ford Expedition at \$27,545.32, 2007 Chev. Trailblazer at \$23,259.00, and a Chev. Tahoe at \$32,872.24. It was consensus of the council to accept the lowest bid for the 2007 Trailblazer 4x4 LS at \$23,259.00, with a trade-in value of \$5,611.00 for the 1999 Ford Explorer. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper and Martz. Nays: No one.

**RESIGNATION ACCEPTED:** There was a motion by Martz seconded by Cooper to accept the resignation of officer Chad Breedlove effective February 1, 2007. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper, and Martz. Nays: No one.

**BRIAN HOLTZLEITER:** Thanked the council and Police Dept. and anyone that helped within the time of Fireman Sid Hall's death. Holtzleiter said that he was meeting with OHSA in regards to Halls death also. Council wanted to thank all Firemen for their help and appreciations for the way the matter was handled.
