

# TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA

## APRIL 24, 2007

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. All members were present. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Joe Romine. There was a motion by Bonham seconded by Martz to approve the minutes from the April 11, 2007 meeting. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper, Martz. Nays: No one.

**UMBAUGH AND ASSOCIATES:** Umbaugh and Associates delivered their annual report for the water and sewage utility. The Council requested that Umbaugh prepare a quote for the May 9<sup>th</sup> meeting for the cost of a study to establish a capacity fee for new structures.

**STORMWATER UTILITY:** There was a motion by Cooper seconded by Bonham to have attorney James McKown prepare an ordinance to establish a stormwater utility. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper, Martz. Nays: No one.

**TRIAD ASSOCIATES:** After a meeting with SRF representatives last week it was determined that the town will have approximately \$90,000.00 unused monies from the SRF Loan. There was a motion by Bonham seconded by Jagers to have Chip Long and Triad meet to prioritize water projects to be completed with unused monies. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper, Martz. Nays: No one.

**ORDINANCE FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES:** McKown reported that he had met with Marshal Parker concerning the request for the town to consider adopting an ordinance to allow recreational vehicles on the streets. He has looked at a copy of Gas City's and theirs is for licensing of golf carts only. McKown did not recommend that the town pursue adopting any ordinance on recreational vehicles due to the expenses it would incur to the town. At this time, the police officers use their discretion on the vehicles, such as allowing them during Labor Day Week-end for the festivities. He felt there was no action required at this time by the Council.

**SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE:** Motion by Cooper seconded by Martz to approve General Ordinance NO. 4-2007, establishing speed limits on town streets. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Romine, Cooper, Martz. Nays: No one. A complete copy of this ordinance is on file in the Clerk's office for any interested parties.

**NEW WATER PLANT UPDATE:** Long reported that the old water plant has been demolished and the mains have been capped to the old plant. New Plant is up and in operation and doing well.

**POTHoles:** Martz inquired who is responsible for the potholes in front of the Post Office and Main and Anson. Long informed her they would be the responsibility of the State Highway. He will call them about the holes.

Their being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, May 9, 2007 at 7:00 p.m.
