

TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA

JUNE 11, 2008

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. All members were present except Cooper. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Vice-President Marva Martz. There was a motion by Jagers seconded by Romine to approve the minutes from the May 28th meeting. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Martz, Romine. Nays: No one.

PAVING: Paving quotes from E & B Paving were discussed with Chip Long and the Council. There is not enough money available to pave all the streets. There was a motion by Romine seconded by Bonham to accept the bids from E & B Paving and to pave as far as our money will allow. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Martz, Romine. Nays: No

SIDEWALKS: Motion by Bonham seconded by Jagers to use the money set aside for sidewalks this year to replace the sidewalk on Second St. in front of the school as far as the money will go. The project will begin at Jefferson St. and go south. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Martz, Romine. Nays: No one.

ENGINEERING SERVICES: Motion by Romine seconded by Jagers to approve an Engineering Services Agreement with Triad Associates for \$16,500.00 for additional water main work for a loop from 3rd St west along Berry St to 900 E then south to connect into an existing main. Also, the connection of an existing main at the north end of Valhalla Street west to 900 E. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Martz, Romine. Nays: No one.

TRASH AND CURBSIDE RECYCLING: Clerk-Treasurer reported that the town has received a letter from Marion Services notifying the Town that they are adding a fuel charge of \$655.98 per month to our monthly bill of \$6597.50 making our total monthly bill \$7253.48. The town currently charges residents \$7.00 a month for the service and the town pays the rest of the fee. Due to the increase the town finds it is necessary to raise the monthly fee to residents to \$9.50 per month effective with the July 1, 2008 billing. There was a motion by Jagers seconded by Romine to approve the increase from \$7.00 to \$9.50 for trash and curbside recycling. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Martz, Romine. Nays: No one.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, June 25th at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall.
