

TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA

October 8, 2008

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session. Bonham was absent from the meeting. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Michael Cooper. There was a motion by Romine seconded by Martz to approve the minutes from the September 24, 2008 meeting. Those voting aye: Jagers, Cooper, Romine, Martz. Nays: No one.

CURFEW ORDINANCE: The Council discussed a curfew ordinance that had been prepared by Jim McKown. Marshal Parker and Assistant Marshal Gerstorff were also at the meeting to discuss the ordinance. Discussion included the fact that there is no curfew law in the state of Indiana. Would we be able to enforce it? Where would the money go that was assessed in fines? The Council decided to defer any action on the ordinance until Jim McKown could be reached to answer some of their questions. The town currently has a curfew ordinance in place until there is a decision made on a new ordinance.

OUR TOWN MEETING: There will be a meeting in the Upland Town Hall on Monday, October 27th at 7:00. The Our Town committee will be meeting to discuss a grant from Main Street U.S.A. for downtown improvements.

FIRE TRUCK: Long reported that he had talked with Brian Holtzleiter concerning a new fire truck. Holtzleiter said the Council was to look into a new truck in 2009. Long has been in contact with Steven Ray from OCRA about a grant for a truck. There is up to \$150,000.00 available for a new truck. They also discussed a refurbished truck. That would be fine with the department but Steve Ray said grant money would only pay for a new truck. No decision was made on the matter.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, October 22nd at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall. There will be an executive session at 6:00 p.m. to discuss personnel.
