The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session. Jagers and Martz were absent from the meeting. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Michael Cooper. There was a motion by Romine seconded by Bonham to approve the minutes from the October 8, 2008 meeting. Those voting aye: Bonham, Cooper, Romine. Nays: No one.

CURFEW ORDINANCE: The Town Council has discussed a Curfew Ordinance for the past two meetings. After discussion with Town Attorney, there was a motion by Romine seconded by Bonham to rescind Ordinance No. 10-2008 (the town's current curfew ordinance) and to adopt Ordinance No. 12-2008 prohibiting juveniles from public places during night-time and early morning hours except under certain circumstances. Those voting aye: Bonham, Cooper, Romine. Nays: No one.

SALT FOR STREETS: Long reported that he had been able to locate salt for this winter for the streets. He was able to order 40 tons. One shipment has been received.

OUR TOWN UPLAND: Cooper reported that there will be a Community meeting on Monday October 27th at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall for a "Main Street" presentation and Analysis results from the May 6th SWOT meeting. The meeting is sponsored by Our Town Upland, Inc.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, November 12, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall.
