JULY 8, 2009

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. All members were present except Bonham and Jagers. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Michael Cooper. There was a motion by Martz seconded by Romine to approve the minutes from the June 24th meeting. Those voting aye: Cooper, Romine, Martz. Nays: No one.

ANIMAL ORDINANCE: Paul Brock 223 Lake Street questioned the Council as to whether or not the town has an ordinance regarding the number of animals allowed on one property. He said his neighbor has eight to twelve dogs and cats. He expressed that the smell is not pleasing. The Council could not find on the books an ordinance about the number of animals allowed. Chip Long will check with Area Plan Commission and Alice Quinn at the Health Department concerning the matter. He will also check in the state statutes. Long will report his findings to Mr. Brock.

WATER MAIN LOOP: Long reported that the loop at Ivanhoe's has been charged and residents are being hooked up.

PAVING ON TOWN STREETS: Long told the Council that the paving on town streets is almost completed.

GOLF CART ORDINANCE: The golf cart ordinance is tabled until further information is received. Cooper has sent an e-mail to Senator Holdman and Representatives Turner and Pearson questioning whether or not a waiver could be obtained on the driver of the golf cart having a valid driver license due to a handicap.

LOCAL ELECTED OFFICIALS MEETING: Cooper attended the Economic Growth Council Local Elected Official meeting on June 30th.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, July 22nd at 7:00 p.m.
