

TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA

OCTOBER 28, 2009

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. Bonham and Cooper were absent from the meeting. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Vice- President Marva Martz. There was a motion by Romine seconded by Jagers to approve the minutes from the October 14, 2009 meeting. Those voting aye: Jagers, Martz, Romine. Nays: No one.

DISASTER RELIEF GRANT: Chip Long reported that he had attended a meeting on Monday evening the 26th of October with Steven Ray. The grant is for infrastructure, water and sewer projects, Fire stations and Fire trucks. There is a 10% match required by the Town. The town is working on applying for a grant in the next round.

COMMUNITY MEETING: There was a Community meeting held on Monday, October 26th at 7:00 P.M. There were approximately 50 people in attendance. Community members were asked to name the positives about our community and things they would like to see in the future. Susie Bruce, Grant Projector Manager with the Community Block Grants will prioritize the information and give to the Council for their review.

DUMP TRUCK: Chip Long reported that the 1991 dump truck has a twisted axle off in the rear end. He should know cost of repairs tomorrow. Council also asked Long to get quotes on replacing the dump truck.

TASK FORCE COMMITTEE MEETING: Jagers gave a report to the Council on the meeting of the Task Force. They are continuing in doing their work. They have a draft of a Historic Preservation Ordinance that they went over tonight. It still needs some scrutiny. Jagers is planning to have a draft for the Council at the November 11th meeting.

BALL STATE UNIVERSITY: Jagers has met with representatives from Ball State University to use their outreach program Building Better Communities. They go into small towns and help them envision their futures by developing a Master Plan. The update at this time is that he has met with them, engaged and made some progress. If both parties are in consensus, there would be a contract signed and a fee charged to complete the Plan. Jagers will keep the Council updated.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, November 11th, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall. There will be an executive session at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of discussing personnel.
