PUBLIC HEARING: AT 7:00 p.m., President Michael Cooper opened a Public Hearing on the proposed 2012 advertised budget. Clerk explained there were no major changes in the budget and there is an average 3% increase across the board. There was no one present from the public to speak for or against the proposed budget. Cooper then closed the Public Hearing.

REGULAR MEETING: Cooper opened the regular meeting at 7:15 p.m. All members were present. There was a motion by Martz seconded by Bonham to approve the minutes from the August 10, 2011. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Cooper, Martz, Schwartz. Nays: No one.

VACATION OF STREETS: Sonny Detamore was at the meeting to discuss vacating Ninth and Tenth Sts. from Indiana to South St. There is a possibility of a housing development there with eight lots. After some discussion, there was a motion by Schwartz seconded by Jagers to give Mr. Detamore a favorable recommendation for him to proceed with the process. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Cooper, Martz, Schwartz. Nays: No one.

WATER LINES: Long reported that the water lines have been installed on Catalina Drive.

GARFIELD: Garfield is tentatively scheduled to be placed at Ivanhoes by Labor Day Week-end.

PLUNGE DAY: Plunge Day with Taylor University will be Thursday, September 1st from 10 a.m to 4 p.m.

LOCAL ELECTED OFFICIALS MEETING: There will be an elected officials meeting on August 30th at 7 p.m. in Jonesboro.

NO PARKING: There will be **No Parking** on S.R. 22 from Jefferson to East Washington, and from East Washington to Lake Street on Sept. 5th 2011 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for the Annual Labor Day Parade.


STREET CLOSING: S.R. 22 will be closed from Indiana St. to Washington St. on Sept. 4th during the Bob Moore Kid's Day.
