

**TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA, SEPTEMBER 28, 2011**

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. All members were present. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Michael Cooper. There was a motion by Martz seconded by Bonham to approve the minutes from the September 14, 2011 meeting. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Cooper, Martz, Schwartz. Nays: No one.

**LAKEVIEW ADDITION:** Two bids were received on repairing the drainage problem in the Lakeview Addition. They were \$15,400.00 from Nottingham Excavating and \$22,500.00 from Keith Sullivan Excavating. It was the recommendation of Town Manager Chip Long to award the contract to Nottingham Excavating. There was a motion by Schwartz seconded by Jagers to approve the contract with Nottingham Excavating in the amount of \$15,400.00. Those voting aye: Bonham, Jagers, Cooper, Martz, Schwartz. Nays: No one.

**SECOND STREET BRIDGE:** Long reported that the town had purchased some boards and repaired the holes on the bridge. Cooper has contacted David White at the County requesting a report from them on stability and the most recent inspection report of the bridge. Cooper is waiting to hear back from White.

**PAVING:** Paving of Third Street should start this week weather permitting.

**GARFIELD:** Schwartz requested that a Thank you note be sent to Nottingham Excavating for the labor of installing Garfield at Ivanhoe's.

**DRAINAGE ON JEFFERSON ST.** Long reported that a "birdhouse cage" had been ordered to put over the drain at Phil Hardley's home on Jefferson St. to help with debris in the drain.

**CATALINA DRIVE:** Long, Bonham, and Schwartz have looked at Catalina Drive concerning the drainage problem there. Long reported that once all the taps have been made, they think they have come up with a solution to fix the problem.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, October 12, 2011 in the Upland Town Hall at 7:00 p.m. There will be a Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m. to adopt the proposed 2012 Budget.
