

**TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA,
MARCH 28, 2012**

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. Cooper and Jagers were absent from the meeting. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Councilman John Bonham. There was a motion by Schwartz seconded by Ross to approve the minutes from the March 14, 2012 meeting. Those voting aye: Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

COMMUNITY BUILDING: Donna Bauer gave the Council a progress report on the Community Building renovation. A lot of the work is being done by volunteers and project is under budget.

RAW SEWAGE PUMP: Long has received one bid for a replacement pump at the wastewater plant in the amount of \$14,175.00. He is waiting on additional bids.

NEW FIRE TRUCK: Chief Brian Holtzleiter thanked the Council for participating in the inspection of fire trucks. The bid package is now complete and ready to be let out for bids. There was a motion by Ross seconded by Schwartz to accept the specs for a new fire truck as presented to the Council. Those voting aye: Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

ORDINANCE NO. 3-2012: Motion by Schwartz seconded by Ross to approve Salary Ordinance No. 3-2012 and Ordinance establishing salary for William Chambers due to completing 15 years of service. Those voting aye: Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

RECYCLING: Schwartz reported that he had some residents complain about recycle items blowing during pick-up. Long has noticed that drivers are picking up loose debris and thanked them for going the extra mile.

CAPACITY FEES: A letter was received from a local contractor asking the Council considering waiving capacity fees for three years. Since only three members were present, the request was tabled.

LIVESTOCK IN TOWN LIMITS: A question was raised about having livestock in town. This item was also tabled until the next meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, April 11, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall. There will be an Administrative meeting at 6:00 p.m.
