

TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA, JULY 11, 2012

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. Jagers was absent from the meeting. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Council Member John Bonham. There was a motion by Schwartz seconded by Ross to approve the minutes from the June 27, 2012 meeting. Those voting aye: Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one. Abstain: Carmin.

DRAINAGE AT LAKEVIEW ADDITION: Long reported that catch basins and manholes have been delivered and now are waiting on pipe to begin the drainage project in the Lakeview Addition.

WATER SHORTAGE WARNING: The Town has received letters from DNR and IDEM alerting us to the fact they have issued a water shortage warning because of drought conditions for several counties including Grant. The objective is to prepare for a possible water supply problem. They are asking for a 10-15% voluntary reduction in current water use. The Town Council is requesting residents voluntarily begin conserving by not watering their grass or washing cars. The situation will continue to be monitored.

STORM DAMAGE: Long reported that the salt and sand bin had been damaged during the storm on June 29th. He is requesting bids to repair.

BARKING DOGS: Stan Slater was at the meeting to thank the police officer that was on duty when he made the call about barking dogs. The dogs have been better since the call. He also asked if the Town ever issued citations for the ordinance violation for the barking dogs and not being restrained by the owners. Marshal Parker responded that we have never issued a citation. Slater thought that we should start enforcing the ordinance and collecting the fines associated with it.

DEPOT PARK: Schwartz requested that the police officers patrol the depot park more often at night. He has had request from concerned citizens.

PARK BOARD MEETING: Ross asked Chip Long if there had been a Park Board Meeting scheduled yet. Long said he had tried to coordinate one three times, but could not get everyone together. He will try again.

RESOLUTION: Motion by Schwartz seconded by Ross to approve a Resolution of a transfer of funds in the General and Continuing Education funds. Those voting aye: Carmin, Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

REORGANIZATION OF COUNCIL: There was a motion by Schwartz seconded by Bonham to reorganize the Council with Jagers as President and Bonham as Vice-

President due to the resignation of Council member Cooper. There was then some discussion on the matter and before the vote was taken Schwartz withdrew his motion and Bonham withdrew his second.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, July 25th at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall. There will be an Administrative meeting at 6:00 p.m. for the discussion of reorganization of the Council.
