

TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA, JULY 2, 2013

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met in regular session on the above date. All members were present. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Chip Jagers. There was a motion by Bonham seconded by Schwartz to approve the minutes from the June 18, 2013 meeting with the correction of a spelling error. Those voting aye: Bonham, Carmin, Jagers, Ross, Schwartz. Nays: No one.

LIONS CLUB: Nancy Gore representing the Lions Club was at the meeting to discuss with the Council the possibility of the Town taking over the lakes owned by the Lions Club. The lakes need to be dredged and an aeration system to clean it. The Council will meet at 6 p.m. on August 6th in an Administrative meeting with members of the Lions Club to discuss the issue further. The town needs to research liability and insurance issues.

SECOND STREET BRIDGE: Long reported that he had attended a pre-construction meeting on the Second St. Bridge. Work should begin on or around July 22nd. The contract is for 100 days making the completion date somewhere around October 31st.

REDISTRICTING OF WARDS: Mr. Forcum recommended that the Council complete the redistricting of the wards as soon as possible. Bonham will look at maps and census numbers, make a report to the Council and a work session with the entire Council will be planned to finish the process.

STEERING COMMITTEE: Jagers reported that the Steering Committee had met on Monday. They are working on the paperwork for the RFQ's for Engineering Firms. The top 4 or 5 firms will be contacted for interviews. The target date for completion of the process is by Labor Day.

ADA COMPLIANCE: Council will review the two quotes for ADA Compliance and hire a firm at the next meeting.

COMMUNITY CHURCH: Schwartz announced there would be a groundbreaking ceremony for the new Equipping Center at the Church after the 10 o'clock service and invited the Council to attend.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned back to executive session. Due to scheduling issues, the next regular meeting will be Tuesday, July 23rd at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall.
