The Town Council of the Town of Upland met on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President John Bonham. There was a motion by Jagers seconded by Carmin to approve the minutes from the April 29, 2014 meeting. Those voting aye: Jagers, Carmin, Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

**PLANNING UPDATE:** Ryan Cambridge with Browning, Day, Mullins and Dierdorf gave the Council an update on the Planning Process. They will be building on the Charette that was done in 2010 by Ball State University. There will be a vision session followed by implementation. Look into options for funding. The Facebook page is now live and there will be a link for a survey that should be completed by June 1st. A hard copy will also be available to those without internet access. The design workshop should occur sometime in June. A one on one interview will be conducted with Stake Holders with a meeting later that evening for public input.

**SALARY ORDINANCE:** Motion by Ross seconded by Jagers to approve Salary Ordinance No. 6-2014 whereas the Council wishes to give raises to Brad Felver and Derik Dollar due to added responsibilities to their jobs. Those voting aye: Jagers, Carmin, Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

**BUDGET HEARINGS:** Bonham announced that Department Heads will be meeting on May 20<sup>th</sup> beginning at 10 am for Budget Hearings. The public is invited.

**INDOT GRANT:** Chip Long is working with Triad on the INDOT grant.

**PARKS UPDATE:** Ross reported that picnic tables had been delivered, park benches are being put together, planters being rebuilt, working on getting new signs for entrance, quotes on new basketball courts and looking into grant opportunities.

**RETIREMENT:** Heath Crouch, Edward Jones will be meeting with Town employees soon to discuss their retirement.
