

TOWN OF UPLAND, INDIANA, JULY 1, 2014

The Town Council of the Town of Upland met on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President John Bonham. There was a motion by Jagers seconded by Schwartz to approve the minutes from the June 3, 2014 meeting. Those voting aye: Jagers, Carmin, Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

ORDINANCE NO. 7-2014: Motion by Schwartz seconded by Ross to hire Zach Hodge as temporary summer help and to approve Salary Ordinance No. 7-2014 establishing a salary of \$10.00 per hour retroactive to June 16th the date of his hire. Those voting aye: Jagers, Carmin, Bonham, Schwartz, Ross. Nays: No one.

ESTIMATE: An estimate was received from Miller Construction for the add on of the street barn. The estimate is \$27,000.00. It was the consensus of the Council to have Chip Long and Schwartz to get together and work out the particulars of each estimate and bring a report back to the August meeting.

LETTER FROM INDOT: A letter was received from INDOT with a response to our request for a traffic signal at the intersection of Main and Berry St. INDOT will complete a new traffic engineering study to determine if traffic control changes or other safety measures are needed but the study will be delayed until after school resumes in late summer in order to capture the school traffic in the study.

PLANNING REPORT: Chip Jagers gave an update on planning from Ryan Cambridge. Phase I is finished. Phase II will begin with putting everything gathered prior into a single report. The original goal is to complete by the end of July but now they will wait until early September when everyone is back from vacation and school has restarted. Results of surveys should be posted in the next two weeks on Facebook.

REGIONAL SMALL TOWN CONFERENCE: Ross reported that he had attended the conference last week at Taylor University.

RAIL PROJECT: The committee for the trail project met last week.

GREENWAY MEETING: Members of the Greenway committee met today for proposal ideas.

PARK UPDATE: Derik and Ralph have been working on the outside of the Community Building. Dead trees and stumps have been removed from the park. Basketball courts should be resurfaced by mid July. Will be looking into grant opportunities for lighting at the park.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned. The next meeting will be Tuesday, July 1, at 7:00 p.m. in the Upland Town Hall. There will be an executive session at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of discussing personnel.
